

ADMISSION POLICY

Hillsdale Beauty College admits regular students who are eighteen years of age or older and have a high school diploma, GED or an official transcript showing that they graduated from high school.

The College does not admit students under the Ability to Benefit Policy.

Hillsdale Beauty College does not discriminate on the basis race, sex, national origin, ethnic origin, color, religion, age or handicap in educational programs, activities, employment or recruitment.

Hillsdale Beauty College does not recruit students currently attending other cosmetology institutions. Under extremely exceptional circumstances students may be allowed to transfer after review by the Corporate Officers.

All prospective students are required to make application to the College and attend a personal interview with the Administrator. Accepted applicants are required to attend an orientation session prior to the start of class.

All students must provide proof of age and education. All files will be reviewed by the administrator and education director to insure that these documents are on file.

Applicants to the Instructor program are required to have a current cosmetology license.

Co-op student's eligibility is determined by their appropriate high school.
